

DIVERSITY CUP 2025 RULES

Basic rules for Diversity Cup for TEAMS

- 8 players on the field (one must be the keeper)
- The game MUST start on time and end on time, so the next game is not delayed
- Every player must have shin guards but it's ok to be on the outside of socks
- Any jewelry on players MUST be removed for safety
 - Taping is not sufficient
- Each team jersey must be the same color (the keeper is a different color)
- Subs can be made only in stop play (throw-in, corner kicks, goal kicks, goals, free kicks)
- Throw-ins must be thrown behind the head with both hands, no rules on feet
- Subs come on at the halfway line, subs can go off anywhere
- Infractions will be explained to the player by the referee (no cards)
- Major fouls will be explained and possibly the player will be subbed off
- Game time is 2 X 30-minute halves with a 2-minute halftime
- NO game sheets. Scores will NOT be posted. This is a round-robin fun tournament
- Parents, players, and coaches can be on the same side of the field because of limited space
- If a referee does not show up, a parent must start the game
- If the score is 5-0 or more, the team winning must remove a player from the field until the goal difference is 4 or less
 - Coaches, please assist the referee in managing this
 - For mixed divisions, this must be a boy who comes off the field
